## Gospel Project: Getting the Most Out of It



By the grace of God, through the Gospel Project children are being raised up in the home, home discipleship training is taking place, and CG members are becoming more established in their faith.

Here's a guide to using the Gospel Project even more effectively.

### Visit the KCPC Website

1. You can find videos of the CG leaders lecture and the Gospel Project-themed Saturday morning prayer.
2. Also available are the session guide (mp3 format) and leader's guide video: hear the main points and important notes for each session. You can listen to it with your family, or on your commute!
3. Question guide: read the intent and background of the discussion questions.
4. Activity resources: See the methods the leaders use to capture attention and make the session interesting.
5. Next Generation resources for each department (for parents): There are videos and conversation materials you can use with your child at home. The Teacher Guidance Video lets you see at a glance what they are learning during the week.

### Keep Your Weekly Bulletin

1. Read through the brief summaries of each chapter, so that you can share with your child what they learned that Sunday on the drive home or later in the evening.
2. Family Talk: Questions to help you naturally ask and share, with the intent of leading to deeper dialogue.
3. If you collect the weekly bulletins, you will have excellent summaries of 99 essential doctrines!

### Read the Emails (For Parents)

Each department will send an email every Tuesday or Wednesday (written at the child's level) to reinforce what they learned during Sunday worship.
