Family Talk

Growing Deeper with the Gospel Project



The 2019 motto of KCPC is "A Church That Raises Up, A Community That Walks Together." First we need to raise up ourselves, and then our families-especially our children.

The sincere hope is that the Gospel Project is being used in community groups to strengthen roots of faith and to increase discipleship within the family.

In family discipleship, parents are the most important and fundamental teachers for their children. Here are four reasons why:

1. Parents love their children more than anyone else loves them.
2. Parents take care of their children more than anyone else cares for them.
3. Parents can spend more time with their children than anyone else spends with them.
4. Parents have more authority and responsibility over their children than anyone else does.

Therefore, parents should be spiritual leaders for their children and be priests in their homes. Meanwhile, the church should establish a solid theology of discipleship, awakening the role of parents and teaching the next generation. Parents can fulfill their mission through Family Talk: discussion points that review the Gospel Project lessons with their children.

1. **Be Together:** Each family will gather together with love and expectation.
2. **Think Together:** Root what you learned in the Gospel project in the Bible, and think and meditate on it together.
3. **Listen Together:** Read the Word of God and listen to it together.
4. **Go Together:** As you start a new week together, live out the lessons you have learned in your daily life (school, work, home, community, etc).

Faith Talk: Designated time, at least once per week, for the household to gather for prayer and to study a biblical truth together. This household gathering may include not only parents and children but also other individuals who have been invited to share this time with the family. The purpose of faith talks is to restore Christian parents to their God-ordained role as teachers of God's Word in their children's lives.
